

1. Dan McCauley-Acting Chair called the meeting to order with round table introductions, welcoming all present. The LHRC minutes of 08/01/06 were reviewed.

**Action:** The CCCA LHRC minutes of 08/01/06 were approved as amended.

2. Chris Ruble-Liberty Point introduced Kathryn Dickerson as a Liberty Point designee who may be attending the CCCA LHRC meetings as needed. He also invited all present to the Liberty Point-sponsored training opportunity entitled "Strength Based Principles & Techniques for Understanding and Responding to Troubled Children and Youth." Mr. Ruble added that key note speakers for the event were Charlie Appelstein and Tim Piccirillo.
3. Mark Seymour-Advocate began the Advocate's Report with a discussion regarding affiliation attendance at the CCCA LHRC meetings. He reported that the DMHMRSAS State Human Rights Committee (SHRC) held their meeting at the Center on 09/01/06 and also toured the facility. Mr. Seymour also reported that the revised draft State human rights regulations had been posted on the DMHMRSAS-Office of Human Rights website for review and comments through November 17, 2006. Valley CSB will be hosting one of the public hearings on 10/11/06, 4:00pm-6:00pm. Speakers are allowed 3 minutes to speak and a written copy of their comments is also required. It is anticipated that the new Regulations will be approved by Spring 2007 and that the training seminar likely will be coordinated for Fall 2007. Mr. Seymour commented that CCCA currently has a wide variety of patients and he noted the facility's efforts in meeting the needs of an impulsive young male who is cognitively impaired.

**Action:** Jim Hall-LHRC Secretary will send a reminder note out to the currently affiliated programs regarding meeting attendance. The CCCA LHRC will also review a draft affiliation agreement at the next meeting.

4. Joe Tuell-Facility Director presented the Facility Director's Report, distributing statistical data regarding CCCA admissions for the past 4-5 years. He noted that the number of female admissions was increasing, both in number and aggressiveness. He also shared CCCA highlights and accomplishments for the past year.
